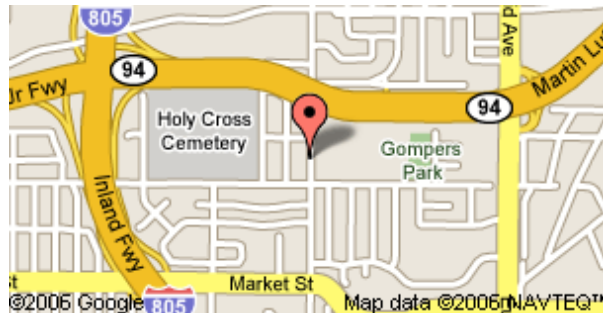
FREE Income Tax Preparation!

Trained and certified volunteers will prepare your income tax returns for free! Student, staff and retired staff from UCSD will prepare and e-file your 2006 federal and California state income tax return.

Most San Diego residents earning less than \$40,000 annually may have a basic return completed. We complete 1040, 1040-A and 1040EZ forms and the California State tax return. We do education credits, EIC and Child Tax Credits. There is **no charge** for any services we provide.

Volunteers will prepare income tax returns on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays from February through April 2007 by appointment. There are two locations for tax return preparation: UCSD Campus and Gompers Charter Middle School. Taxes are prepared by appointment. **Please call the number to the left after February 5 to make your appointment!**

Gompers Charter Middle School is located at 1005 47th Street, San Diego, CA 92102. *Appointments available for Thursday evenings only.*



Tax returns prepared at the **UCSD Campus** location are prepared at the computer lab adjacent to Student Legal Services. Student Legal Services is located on the corner of Gilman Drive and Mandeville Lane on the first floor. It is building # 299 on the UCSD Campus Map (available for download at <http://parking.ucsd.edu>).

Parking is free on the weekend, but there is a charge during the week.
